Job Purpose: The postholder will provide clinical supervision and demonstration of clinical dental procedures, within the GDC scope of DH/DT practice, to undergraduate DH/DT and BDS dental students and will also contribute to student support and the assessment of clinical competence.

Offer guidance to students in clinical dental practice, within the GDC scope of practice5. Assess student feedback and provide feedback6. Assist in the delivery of OSCE assessments7. Provide pastoral support to students and sign-post to appropriate university services where required8. Attend and contribute to relevant meetings9. Undertake administrative duties in relation to the clinical supervision of students10. Contribute towards the recruitment and admission of dental students11. Maintain own clinical skills and continue to develop teaching and learning skills12. Carry out any other duties commensurate with the grade
