Main Duties and Responsibilities	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Plan and deliver clinical skills teaching sessions to undergraduate School of Medicine students, ensuring that the outcomes of the undergraduate curricula and the requirements of the professional bodies are met.2. To act as a clinical skills module leader within School of Medicine programme(s) with responsibility for development of teaching material.3. Organise and co-ordinate assessments (OSCEs) as part of the clinical skills team for undergraduate School of Medicine students.4. Undertake quality assurance activity with clinical skills teaching, developing and implementing new teaching methods as appropriate. This includes updating existing lesson plans to incorporate the latest evidence based clinical practice and teaching strategies.5. Assist with the recruitment and briefing of volunteer and simulated patients who have a role in teaching and assessment.6. To take responsibility for academic administration in relation to specified teaching activity7. As part of the wider team, to support teaching and learning strategies and to engage in development activity within the programmes. This will include acting as an academic advisor and if needed taking a role in student selected component supervision.8. To contribute towards the School's research interests.9. To work productively as part of a team by participating actively in group and school meetings	

10. To participate in the student admission process: open days, recruitment and selection events.
11. To engage in commercial/income-generating activity
12. To take a proactive approach to own academic development.
13. To undertake any other duties relevant to the School's activities and commensurate with the level of the post, as directed by the Head of School , Programme and Theme leads
