To contribute to and develop research within an area of medical sciences linked to research interests in the school.  7. To supervise undergraduate and postgraduate student research effectively.  8. To work productively as part of a team by actively participating in group and school meetings.  9. To participate in the student admission process: open days, recruitment and selection events.  10. To engage in commercial/income-generating activity.
