Undertake recruitment and selection of Nursing students to meet agreed targets.6. Develop and prepare appropriate clinical placements including educational audit and clinical liaison.7. Facilitate and support University quality assurance initiatives as required.8. Provide support for students and mentors during their educational experience.9. Contribute toward the academic reputation of the school through knowledge exchange activities.10. Anything else deemed appropriate by the Academic Team Leader/ Head of School / Executive Dean of Faculty.
